Literacy

We begin our learning in term one by writing a setting description based on Cole's Kingdom. Next, we will write a newspaper report based on Roman society and learn haiku poems in forest school. In term two, we will be learning about myths and legends and focus on the story of Romulus and Remus. Next, we will be writing a discussion argument for and against a subject and presenting visual poems linked to the Romans. We will create writing toolkits which will help to build the children's confidence in applying SPAG and writing structures independently.

Mathematics

The children will learn through Power Maths. Tasks will include a sequence of fluency, reasoning and problem-solving to build confidence and stamina. Year 5 will cover area and perimeter, graphs and tables, properties of shapes, position and direction, adding and subtracting decimals, negative numbers, converting measures and calculating volume. Year 6 will cover area and perimeter, volume, algebra, properties of shapes, position and direction and apply their previous learning through problem solving in all areas from place value through to shape.



Computing

This term we will be looking at Programming- selection in physical computing. We will look at connecting crumbles, combining output components, controlling with conditions, starting with selection, drawing designs and writing and testing algorithms.

Main Theme:

The Conquering Romans
