#### Literacy

We begin our learning with poetry which conveys different feelings, moods or reflections. Next, we will delve into an Egyptian adventure story and finish Autumn One with a non-fiction letter linked to our learning in science about habitat protection and climate change. In Autumn Two, the children will revise their learning of recount writing through writing about our school trip. After, we will be looking closely at biographical writing and will end our Autumn term with a poem focusing on rhythm and rhyme linked to our Egyptian topic. We will create writing toolkits which will help to build the children's confidence in applying SPAG and writing structures independently.



## Computing

#### **Mathematics**

The children will learn through Power Maths. Tasks will include a sequence of fluency, reasoning and problem-solving to build confidence. stamina and independence. Year 5 will focus on place value within 1.000.000. addition and subtraction (mental and written methods), multiplication and division mental methods. equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions. Year 6 will focus on place value within 10,000,000, the four operations: addition. subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions including equivalent, adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. Year 6 will end with measure and look at imperial and metric measures.

#### Art

This term the children will be using their sketchbooks to collect ideas and build their historical research skills by observing closely primary and secondary sources showing Egyptian sculptures and artefacts. The children will be recreating various artefacts found in the sarcophagus: jewellery, canopic jars, papyrus paper and scarab beetles.

Science: All Living Things and Their Habitats – life cycles of mammals, amphibian, and birds. Animals including Humans – changes as humans develop to old age. Children will be exploring how plants reproduce and investigating, researching, and comparing different life cycles. Next the children will be finding out about the human life timeline, the growth and development of babies, changes as we get older and different gestation periods and life expectancies.

#### **Design Technology**

Children will be researching and observing the workings of the Egyptian Shadoof. Children will investigate using levers and pulleys in order to understand and use mechanical systems in their own products.
