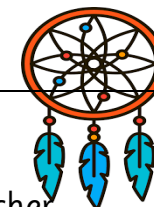

Read every day this term and receive a special reward in class! Don't forget to ask your adult to sign your reading diary.

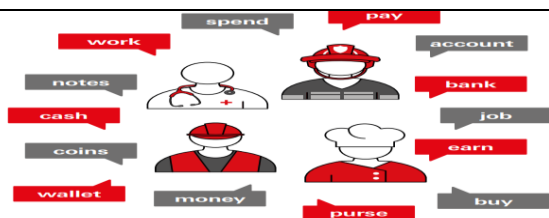
