## Literacy

Have three jugs of coloured water: red, yellow, and blue.

In second bowl, pour some of the red water.

What will happen if you add some yellow?

In a third bowl, pour some of the red water.

What will happen if you add some blue?

Take pictures of the coloured water. Can you tell me what happened?

## Maths

See what patterns you can make using these treasures. Can you copy a pattern your grown-up has made?



## How have I changed?

Look at pictures of you as a baby and the adults in your home as a baby.

Do you look the same? Do you look different?

## How do you celebrate birthdays?

Draw a picture of you on your birthday.

Did you wear anything special? Did you eat any special foods? Who did you celebrate with?
