PARENTS PLEASE PARK CONSIDERATELY AND THINK ABOUT CHILDREN'S SAFETY

Derbyshire Police are receiving a number of complaints from local residents regarding inconsiderate and potentially dangerous parking during school drop off and collection times. Police Warnings or Penalty Points will be issued in this area for individuals who park in this manner.

Do not put children at risk by doing any of the following:-

- ◆ **Parking / stopping / waiting on zig zag markings (outside of a school) and on pedestrian crossings**
- ◆ **Parking on double yellow lines**— These lines are there to stop vehicles parking in dangerous locations, and in areas that could restrict vehicles movements
- ◆ **Parking within 10 metres of a Junction (Highway Code)**
- ◆ **Double park to pick up or drop off**

Your driving license can be endorsed with penalty points if the Police witness you doing any of the following:-

Parking dangerously , causing an obstruction (blocking people's driveways), Parking on pedestrian crossings

Remember as a driver and a parent you have a responsibility to stop and think about whether you are parking in a safe and considerate manner. If your not, you could be endangering a child's life.
